APRIL 9, 2018

Ben Buehler-Garcia spoke of his Tucson history with the University of Arizona and various military organizations. That eventually led him to take over the American Warrior weekly radio show when the program’s founder passed away.

He described the creation of American Warrior Radio by local media icon Dave Sitton. Dave wanted to be a Marine but injured his shoulder playing baseball at U of A. Then there were stories about being the Honorary Commander of Davis Monthan AFB, working with/for Lt. General Robin Rand. His prior experience as a Firefighter as well as being on the Board of the Industrial Development Authority of Tucson gave him opportunities to make valuable contacts within the greater Tucson community. Ben volunteers with various Military charities such as the USS Tucson 770 Club, the Employer Support of the Guard & Reserve, the 9/11 Tower Challenge Foundation and the Tucson Community Cares Foundation.

His conclusion emphasized that Ben is a citizen who is proud to support the military men and women of the US Military. The President presented Mr. Buehler-Garcia with a Fort Lowell-Apache Chapter mug in appreciation for his military support.
